RULES AND REGULATIONS

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

1. Each driver must submit a completed entry form along with the specified entry fee. \$40.00 pre-entry received by April 1, 2012
\$ 50.00 entry fee at the gate.
The fee covers the access for the truck and driver
Pit passes will be \$25.00 each for additional passes.
2. Each driver must have a valid driver's license and be a minimum of 18 years of age.
3. Each driver and anyone entering the pit must sign a waiver and release of liability. This form releases the Lamar Racing Club and all sponsors and anyone involved in promoting this event from any and all liability resulting from participation in this event.
4. All drivers are required to attend the drivers meeting.
5. All Judges Decisions will be final.
6. All trucks are to be removed from the Lamar Speedway pit area following the completion of the event. Trucks not removed will become the property of the Lamar Speedway and will be removed at the expense of the truck owner
7. Lamar Speedway or anyone affiliated with the event will not be held responsible for any truck parts or personal property before, during or after the event.
8. Lamar Speedway reserves the right to approve or reject any or all entries.
9. Absolutely no alcoholic beverages will be allowed in the pits or in the area! This includes anyone in your pit area and/or pit crew. If found with alcohol you will be told to leave immediately and all monies will be forfeited.

Mud Run Rules:

1. All drivers and any passengers must wear seat belts.
2. Tires must be D.O.T. approved- no cut tires will be allowed.
3. No more than one passenger is allowed in the vehicle during the event.
4. No chargers or nitrous will be allowed.
5. We will have 4 classes of Mud Runs, depending on the size of the tire:
 - a. 0"-34"
 - b. 35"-38"
 - c. 39"-and up
 - d. Women's Open Division- includes any tire size/ no nitrous and/or chargers.
 - * We may have an "Open" Class Division if we have enough interested, please let me know. The "Open" class will be anything goes. If you have nitrous etc. you are required to wear a helmet as well.
6. Winners will be based on fastest time thru the mud (average of the two runs).
7. We will be running two pits and two runs will be ran per vehicle entry.
8. If no one is able to make it across the pit, winners will be based on the longest distance.
9. If for any reason you must be pulled out of the pit, the Lamar Racing Club will not be held responsible for any damages.
10. Make sure that any tow hooks/rings, etc. are readily accessible.
11. If you decide not to supply the hook to hook up the tow rope, and you become stuck, it is the drivers responsibility to go into the mud to hook it up. Not the Judges.
