July 6, 2010

The regular monthly meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by President Kelley Morris at the Ports to Plains Restaurant. There was a good gathering of members despite everyone's busy summer schedules. On the agenda for Old Business: June 12th Race, July 2nd race, July 3rd race. New Business: Drag Race August 7th, August 14th race, August 27th BST race, Mud Run September 18th, Jeffery Schiffer Memorial Fund.

The Treasurer's report was given by Daina Morris. The minutes to the last meeting were read by Daina and were approved and accepted as read.

All three race reports were given by Kelley Morris. June 12 was a windy cloudy day but cars and fans showed up to participate in the in the nights events. All of the Heat Races were run. At the end of the Modified Heat races rain was falling, the track was too slick to do any more racing. One attempt to dry the track failed. By this time it was a perfect track for the Anything Goes. After the Anything Goes event red tickets were given to all of the fans to use at the July 3rd race for half price admission. July 2nd was the BST Points Race. Although there were plenty of cars and fans the wind blew and the track was drying out fast and becoming dry slick. 24 Modifieds started the main event. It was a really good race. A lot of fans have told us how they enjoyed all of the racing that night. However BST didn't do what they had promised to do, as for more cars and helping to promote the race, so the night was a disappointment for the Lamar Racing Club. July 3rd was another windy day; again there was another good showing of cars and a good crowd. However the number of pit passes exceeded the number of general admission tickets sold. It was Scout Night and the Boy Scouts and the Girl Scouts provided the opening to the night's events. A big Thank You goes out to all of them. Fan Appreciation cash giveaways were conducted in the stands. Prizes and cash that were provided by a number of sponsors were given to those that brought their red ticket from the June 12th race for the drawings. \$350.00 plus tools and other prizes and two checks provided by Keith Nidey were given away. Our fans have again let us how much they enjoyed Saturday nights races.

The Speedway Director, Ron Cook came to the meeting to get guidance from the club on how to deal with the rough driving that is occurring in the stock car class. After a lengthy discussion the club was unanimous. Rough driving will not be tolerated anytime. Track officials will have the full support of the Lamar Racing Club in handling these matters. A rolled up black flag at the Drivers meeting will be the first warning to all of the drivers.

A mischief incident involving a driver and damage to another driver's property after Saturday's, races were brought to the attention of Kelley Morris. There was another lengthy discussion and the club decided that camping in the pit area will no longer be allowed. Gates will be locked 1 ½ hours after the last checkered flag, and reopened the next day for those who have left property over night.

The FAA has nixed the Drag Races at the air port on August 7th for the present time.

The club voted to contribute \$100.00 to the Jeffery Schiffer Memorial Fund. This fund is to help Jeffery's wife and little daughter. Anyone wishing to contribute to this fund can do so by contacting the Colorado East Bank.

Items that will be coming up at the August meeting will be: August 7th, Eads festival, cars and booth, August 14th race and cars for the Fair Parade, August 27th BST Points Race?, and the proposed September 18th Mud Run.
